- 1) Opening and Closing Act – All participants on the stage! Every participating act will be part of this choreographies where everybody sing and dance. PARENTS: This means we have to make time for the kids to be on rehearsals (TBD) PARTICIPANTS: links with music, lyrics and a support choreography video will be provided. Your parents will have this in their inboxes as soon as we decide what songs we will use for 2019.
- 2) National Anthem will be performed with music and by those interested participants. Audition necessary. Interested in MCeeing the event? Let us know. You have a production interest? (5th graders) we want to work with you!
- 3) Please have your kids practicing their chosen act as much as they can in their own times, learning their lyrics and routines and most of all, having fun with it. This way when big group rehearsal times comes it won't feel as a point of pressure.
- 4) *Each act will be no more than 1.45 to two minutes long.
- 5) All performances and costumes must be G-rated and family oriented, but please be super creative and let your imagination take you to create your costume!
